

AND NOW A WORD FROM YOUR PASTOR (pg. 1)...


This bulletin will be printed and available at the time of St. Mary's annual bazaar on Labor Day Sunday, September 3rd. Visitors are often amazed and impressed that our bulletin is a monthly bulletin not a weekly publication as in most parishes. I pioneered this concept of parish communication, I think, in my first parish as pastor of St. Gregory the Great on the east side of Houston. I realized how much time it took the parish secretary each week to put out the

bulletin, often with the same information, just highlighting the week's happenings. Often something was overlooked and an announcement at the Sunday Mass would have to be made. I also thought that, with a monthly bulletin, families would be able to plan their schedules around the parish's monthly schedule and not be blind-sighted on Sunday. Selfishly, I'm willing to write a message once a month and, even then, have to be hounded by the secretary to get it in. I applaud priests who do write a weekly message. I don't have the time or inclination .. .lol.

If you are a visitor to the bazaar, I want to thank you for coming. Many of you have traveled quite a distance to be here and support and enjoy the day. We all sincerely appreciate that you put the date on your calendar and made the time to be with us. I hope that, reading through this bulletin, you'll discover that we are a very active and engaging parish family. Though we might be a church in-the-middle-of-nowhere, we have a lot going on. I joke that downtown at the Chancery they think of us as a small, country parish. I'm still trying to find that quiet, bucolic church, though, when I first got here, cows were grazing right up to the fence facing the church! We've grown a lot through the years, now numbering about 1350+ families. Your coming to our bazaar gives us the opportunity to welcome all of you and hopefully be seen as a family of faith that enjoys each other's company, working together and doing this for the honor and glory of God ... and a few extra bucks to keep the light on.

Many of you come during the month to visit the church and admire what has been handed down to us through the years. We are quick to acknowledge that we're just building up what we received through the firm faith and hard work of many generations. What is remarkable and the hallmark of St. Mary is that there are no distinctions made of the old timers and the new comers. (Though sometimes it's said jokingly that St. Mary is the meeting of John Deere and Ralph Lauren .. .lol). The Gathering Hymn at every Mass at every bazaar says it all: All Are Welcome To This Place. It's that genuine and generous welcome that we hope you feel the moment you step foot on this property that we hold is holy.

Of course, the church building is central to the 57+ acres that comprise the setting of St. Mary. I hope you notice that the hall reflects the architecture of the church structure. It's deliberate. What happens in the sacred space of the church building is carried into the hall where fellowship deepens and feeding continues. That feeding and fellowship in Church and Hall spills over into the Family Life building where education of the young and adults continues to nourish and deepen our faith and witness to the Lord as His family gathered i'n this corner of Texas. It's a wonderful cycle ... church ... to hall ... to family life to church ... to hall ... We're a remarkable family. So glad you have come. Come back and join us in worship on Sunday anytime. The church is beautiful but never more beautiful that when full and we're all worshiping together. A sight to behold! An experience to be cherished!




